The Goat Classes/Milking Competitions, are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and the name of the exhibitor, the registered name and number being quoted on the entry form. (Also the kidding date for goats in milk.) All goats in milk must be kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to date of Show. No pregnant goats are allowed on Showground.

Usk Farmers' Club Limited reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation.

The **British Goat Society** offers:

1. A ROSETTE for the Best Goat in Show.
2. A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE for the Best Goat that has borne a kid.
3. A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE for the Best Inspection/Production Goat.
4. A BREED CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE for the Best Goat that has borne a kid in each of the following breeds: Anglo-Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg, British-Alpine, British-Guernsey, British-Saanen, British-Toggenburg and Golden Guernsey.
5. A CERTIFICATE OF MERIT for the Best British Milker that has borne a kid.

MILKER - must have kidded a minimum of 30 days before Show date.

GOATLING - that has not borne a kid, over one but not exceeding two years old.

9. Saanen or British Saanen
10. Anglo Nubian
11. Golden Guernsey
12. Any Other Variety

FEMALE KID - over two months but not exceeding one year.

13. British Alpine
14. Toggenburg or British Toggenburg
15. Saanen or British Saanen
16. Anglo Nubian
17. Golden Guernsey
18. Any Other Variety

MILKING COMPETITION for:-

19. Goats that have kidded once only
20. Goats that have kidded more than once

N.B. Goats entered in classes 1 - 6 and 19 & 20 can arrive at the Showground after midday on Friday 8th September 2017, for **Veterinary Inspection**, carried out on arrival or in the pens (**Welsh Government Regulations**) and stripped out at 6.00 p.m. prompt to the satisfaction of approved stewards.

Goats entered in all other classes to arrive by 9.00 a.m. on Saturday 9th September 2017.

Neither the Welsh and Marches Goat Society, its Officers or Stewards, nor Usk Farmers' Club Ltd shall be responsible for any accident, damage or loss, however caused, that may occur to any exhibitor, or his servant, or to any article or property brought to the Showground.

All entries require certificate from CAE Negative tested whole herd within twelve months of Show date.
